

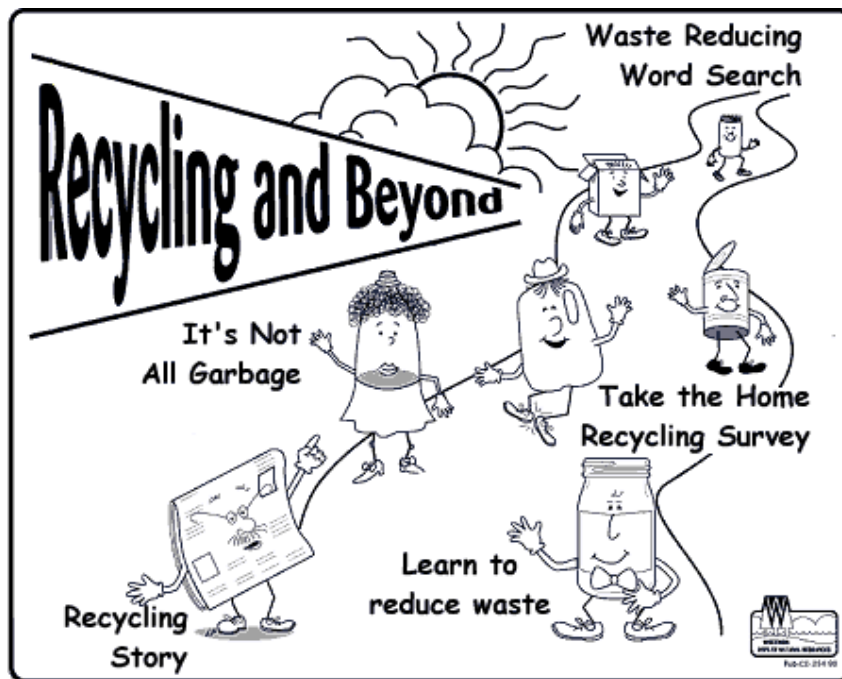

All paper, newspaper and magazines



Glossy leaflets, magazines, catalogues, newspaper, junk mail and envelopes (N.B. Personal documents such as bank statements should not go in)

Cardboard

Cereal boxes
corrugated card and
greetings cards



Food and drink cans

Aluminium and steel
(please rinse them out)



All plastic bottles



e.g. Fizzy drinks, milk,
fruit juice, squash,
mineral water, household
cleaners and detergents



San Francisco's three-cart recycling system, called Fantastic Three, has improved recycling by an average of 90 percent.

N.B. Please squash all containers and remove lids if possible.

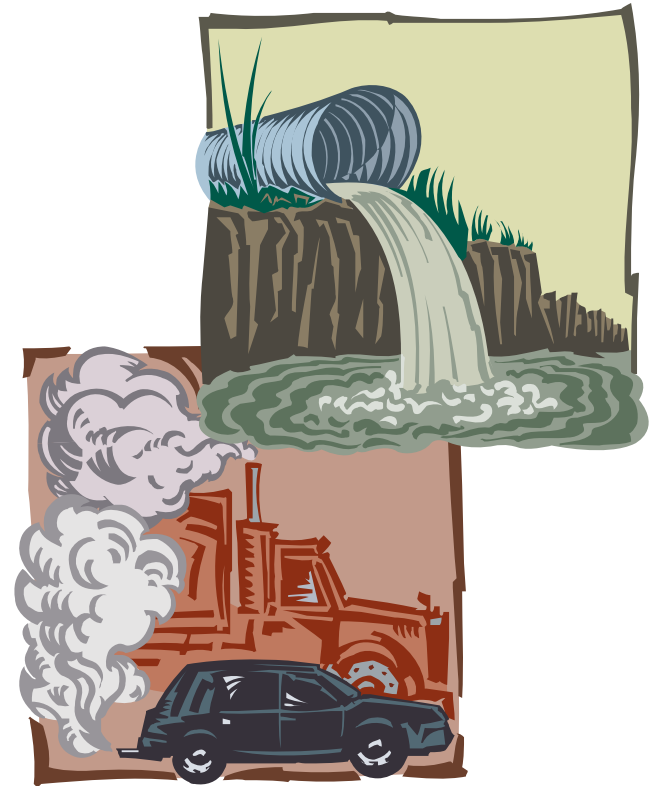
If your domestic green top wheeled bin is too big for your needs, or if you're having difficulty handling it, we can exchange it for a smaller bin.
