1. Sleeping Beauty
(= „Alvó Szépség”)
Sitting Bull
(= „Ülő Bika”)
2. I like swimming.
I can't stand fishing.
(= „úszás”,
„horgászás”)
3. Swimming is good
for you.

Az ige –ing végű alakjának tehát önálló jelentése van. Lehet jelző, alany vagy tárgy.

Present Progressive/Continuous

- Form/positive s.: am/ is/ are +...ing
I'm working.
You're learning.
She's eating.
We're going home.
You're watching TV.
They're sleeping.
- Form/negative s.: 'm not/
isn't/aren't +...ing
- Form/questions: am I...?/
are you...?/is she...?

Use of Present Progressive

- **Itt és most** történik a cselekvés
 - What's happening here?
 - We are having a party.
- Szokásostól eltérően, **átmenetileg**
 - This week** I'm not going to school.
 - Why?
 - I have a cold. The doctor says I can't go.
- Megbeszélte, **egyeztetett időpont** a jövőben
 - Are you doing anything **tonight**?
 - I'm going to the cinema with Kate.
- **Idegcső szokás**
You're **always** losing your keys!
