



They play chess, talk about old days, drink beer and relax after lunch.



Past Tenses

- 1. When I <u>got</u> home, my mother <u>made</u> dinner for me.
- 2. When I got home, my mother was making dinner for me.
- 3. While I <u>was cleaning up</u>, my mother <u>was</u> <u>making</u> dinner.
- When/By the time I <u>got</u> home, my mother <u>had</u> <u>made</u> dinner for me.
- When I <u>got</u> home, my mother <u>had been</u>
 <u>cooking for</u> more than two hours.
