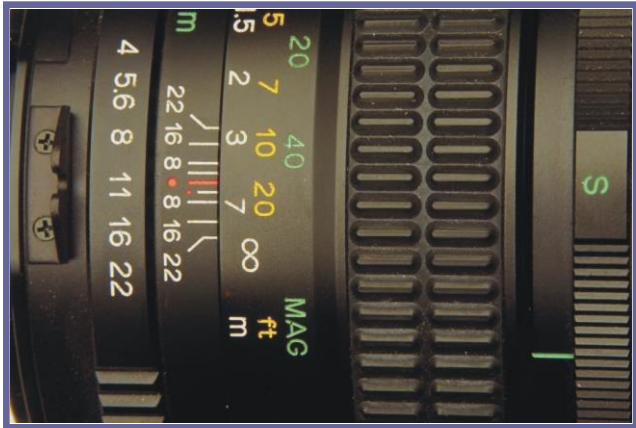

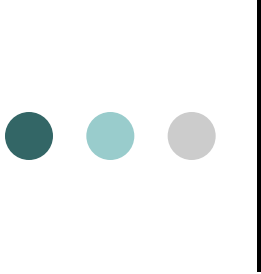



- **I would (=I'd) rather you left immediately.**
- Tehát a „would rather” után az következik, akitől elvárunk valamit, majd következik az adott ige 2. alakja, ami ebben az esetben feltételes mód.
